CELTICS QUICK NOTES

The Celtics improved their league-leading home record to 36-4 with a 131-98 win over the Charlotte Hornets... The Celtics' 36 wins at TD Garden this season, is tied for the third-most home wins in a single season in franchise history... The C's went 40-1 on the parquet in 1985-86 and 39-2 during the 1986-87 season.

This is the third time since 1985-86 that the Celtics went an entire season without losing three consecutive games and the 12th time in franchise history... Boston has won 17 games by 25-or-more points this season, marking the most 25-point wins in NBA history.

Payton Pritchard scored a career-high 31 points and finished with three rebounds, 11 assists, and a steal, marking his third career double-double and second this season – March 17, 2024 at Washington (14 pts, 13 ast); April 9, 2023 (30 pts, 14 rbs, 11 ast)... Pritchard is the first Celtic in the play-by-play era to have at least 23 points and nine assists in the first half of a game and is the second player to reach those numbers this season (Luka c)... His 23 first-half points also represent a career-high for any half after connecting on 10-of-15 made field goals (3-7 3FG)... Pritchard is the first Celtic since Isaiah Thomas in January 2017 to have at least 13 points and five assists in a first quarter, while Paul Pierce achieved those marks three times.

On April 12, **Sam Hauser** registered 16 points, four rebounds, and two assists, while knocking down at least four three-pointers for the 18th time this season, including 14 such games off the bench which ranks fourth amongst NBA reserves... Luke Kornet registered his second-highest scoring game this season with 16 points and grabbed 10 rebounds, for his fourth career double-digit rebound performance.

The Celtics went 4-1 in their season series against the Knicks after dropping a 118-109 decision to New York on April 11... The C's recorded four wins against New York in a single season for the first time since 2010-11 when they swept the series 4-0.

The Celtics were riding a 13-game home winning streak entering tonight's game that spanned from Feb. 4 – April 7... Boston also posted a franchise record 20 consecutive wins on the parquet to start the season from Oct. 27 – Jan. 17... The Celtics are the eighth team in NBA history to have multiple distinct home-winning streaks of 13+ games in a single season and marks the fourth time since 2000-01.

The Celtics knocked down 16 three-pointers breaking the franchise record for most made threes in a single season with 1,321, which also ranks third in NBA history behind only Golden State in 2022-23 (1,363 3FG) and Houston in 2018-19 (1,323 3FG)... The Celtics 38.8 three-point percentage also ranks second in franchise history, trailing only the 2008-09 season when the team went 538-for-1,355 (.397 3FG%)... An NBA team has made at least 1,000 three-pointers in a single season 67 times in league history... The C's 38.8 three-point percentage ranks eighth among those seasons.

The Celtics were held to a season-low 91 points in their 104-91 loss at Milwaukee on April 9... The Celtics are the first team in NBA history to not attempt a free throw in a game, while the Bucks committed just four total fouls, marking the fewest by a team in a game in league history.

Against the Bucks, **Jayson Tatum** led the Celtics with a game-high 22 points along with five rebounds and six assists, while **Jaylen Brown** scored 14 points, added a career-high-tying four steals, and hauled in 10 rebounds for his sixth double-double of the season... Brown is the 11th Celtic to register two-or-more career games with at least 14 points, 10 rebounds, and four steals.

The Celtics currently hold a 13-game advantage over the No. 2 seed Milwaukee Bucks, which would tie the fourth-largest season-ending lead in NBA history... The all-time NBA record is 16 games held by Golden State (1975-76), and the St. Louis Hawks (1959-60; 1958-59).

Kristaps Porzingis was named the NBA Eastern Conference Player of the Week for games played from April 1-7... Porzingis collects his fourth career Player of the Week award and his first honor since Jan. 2, 2023... Porzingis becomes the fourth Celtic to win the weekly honor this season, joining Derrick White (March 25), Jaylen Brown (March 4), and Jayson Tatum (Nov. 6)... The Celtics are the first team in NBA history to have four different players win Player of the Week in a single season since the award's inception in 1979-80.

Boston has finished the regular season with more than 62 wins only five times in franchise history (2007-08; 1985-86; 1984-85; 1981-82; 1972-73)... The 1972-73 Celtics own the most regular season wins with a 68-14 overall record... The Celtics 91.9 home winning percentage ranks fourth in franchise history and is the highest mark since the 1986-87 squad went 39-2. **Jaylen Brown** became the 15th player in Celtic history to reach the 10,000-career point milestone.

The last time the C's were the No. 1 overall seed was in 2007-08 when the squad finished 66-16... Boston has recorded at least 60 wins for the 14th time in franchise history for the most 60-win seasons in the NBA, followed by the Los Angeles Lakers (11) and the San Antonio Spurs (7)... The C's 35-point margin of victory is their third largest win against the franchise all-time, following Boston's 139-92 win against the Sonics in 1968 and a 114-70 win in 2003... The Celtics currently boast the best offensive rating in the play-by-play era (122.6)... - The Celtics currently hold a 15-game advantage over the No. 2 seed Milwaukee Bucks, which would tie the second-largest season-ending lead in NBA history... The all-time NBA record is 16 games held by Golden State (1975-76), and the St. Louis Hawks (1959-60; 1958-59).
- Boston has recorded at least 60 wins for the 14th time in franchise history for the most 60-win seasons in the NBA (below):

BROWN CLIMBS CELTICS' ALL-TIME SCORING LIST

Jaylen Brown scored 23 points on April 3 vs. OKC, and added seven rebounds, four assists, and two blocks... Brown surpassed Hall of Famer Don Nelson for 15th on the Celtics' all-time scoring list... Nelson had 9,983 points in 872 games, while Brown has totaled 10,009 points in just 538 games since being drafted in 2016... Brown also looks to become the first player to reach the 10,000-point threshold in the 2016 draft class that includes: Ben Simmons, Brandon Ingram, and Jamal Murray.

- On April 7, Brown became the 15th player in Celtics history to reach 10,000 career points when he finished a driving layup at the 11:29 mark in the third quarter in Boston 124-107 win over the Portland Trail Blazers.
- Among the 15 Celtics to register at least 10,000 points, Brown's 48.1 field goal percentage ranks fourth behind Kevin McHale (55.4), Robert Parish (55.2), Larry Bird (49.6).

MAINE CELTICS ADVANCE TO FIRST EVER NBA G LEAGUE FINALS

On April 7, DJ Steward came through with 19 fourth-quarter points and Jordan Walsh added 10 points in crunch time, leading Maine to a 99-77 win over the Long Island Nets and sending the Celtics to the G League Finals for the first time in franchise history.

- JD Davison added 19 points and 11 assists while Neemias Queta tallied 16 points and a career-high 19 rebounds. Walsh turned in 15 points and seven rebounds and Drew Peterson had 12 points.
- In Game 1 of the NBA G League Finals, JD Davison, Drew Peterson, and Neemias Queta all recorded 20-point double-doubles as the Maine Celtics cruised to a 106-86 victory over Oklahoma City... Davison finished with 23 points, four rebounds, and 12 assists, Queta had 20 points, 13 rebounds, and three blocks while Peterson tallied 20 and 11 boards, along with five assists, and three steals... Jordan Walsh added 15 points, six rebounds, two blocks, and three steals.

RUNNING UP THE SCORE

Boston has been posting statement wins this season... On April 3, the C's registered their 16th 25-point win of the season, the most by any team in NBA history, topping the previous record of 15 held by Milwaukee (1970-71; 1971-72) and San Antonio (2015-16).

- The Celtics have also won 9 games by at least 30 points this season, which is tied for the second-most such games in a single season in NBA history, alongside the 2016-17 Warriors and trailing the 1971-72 Bucks (10)... The C's nine 30-point wins is the most such wins by the club since the 1987-88 season with eight total.

THE UNICORN ERA CONTINUES

Kristaps Porzingis became the second player in Celtic history to amass at least 27 points, 12 rebounds, four assists, and five blocks in a game since blocks became an official stat in 1974... Robert Parish reached each of those marks three times during his career (1986; 1982; 1980)... Became the 1st Celtic ever to log at least 10 rebounds, 5 blocks, and 3 threes in a game.

- KP posted his fifth career game with at least five blocks, four assists, and three three-point field goals, which is the most in NBA history, passing Kevin Durant who has posted at least those numbers in four career games.
- Porzingis signed with the Celtics in June, 2023... He has since recorded 5 games with at least 5 blocks, which is tied for the sixth-most games in Celtics history, joining Robert Parish, Kevin McHale, and Kendrick Perkins.

WHITE HOT PERFORMANCE EARNS PLAYER OF THE WEEK HONORS

Derrick White has been named the NBA Eastern Conference Player of the Week for games played from March 18-24, the NBA announced today. White earns his second career Player of the Week award (Feb. 13, 2023) and becomes the third Celtic to win the weekly honor this season, joining Jaylen Brown (March 4) and Jayson Tatum (Nov. 6). The Celtics are the only team in the NBA to have three different players earn the recognition this season.

- White helped lead the Celtics to an undefeated 4-0 week with wins over Chicago (124-113), Detroit (129-102; 119-94), and Milwaukee (122-119). White was the only player in the NBA to average at least 20.3 points, 6.5 rebounds, 8.8 assists, and 1.0 blocks during the week.
- Only NBA player to register at least 35 assists and fewer than six turnovers and he grabbed the second-most rebounds among Eastern Conference guards with 26 boards. White boasted the second-best plus/minus in the East at +41, trailing only teammate Payton Pritchard's +53 (min 75 MP).

DERRICK WHITE POSTS FIRST CAREER TRIPLE-DOUBLE

Derrick White recorded his first career triple-double with 22 points (8-20 FG, 6-12 3FG), 10 rebounds, 10 assists, two steals, and a block in the C's 119-94 win over Detroit (3/18)... White joins Jaylen Brown as the only two players to post a triple-double this season and is one of only 11 Celtics to accomplish that feat since 2015.

- White is just the third player in Celtic history to post a triple-double while making at least six threes, including Payton Pritchard vs. the Hawks last season.
- White scored his 5000th career point on a 3-pointer at the 9:52 mark of the 4th quarter and has knocked down at least 6 three-pointers in a career single-season high five games.



HAUSER RAINS THREES

Sam Hauser posted career-highs of 30 points and 10 made 3-pointers to help Boston beat the Wizards 130-104 on March 17... The Celtics are now 26-17 on St. Patrick's Day all-time and have won three of their last five matchups on the day... Jayson Tatum also scored 30 points (8-17FG) with six threes and added six rebounds, six assists, three steals, and a block... Hauser and Tatum are the 1st duo in NBA history to score at least 30 points apiece while playing fewer than 27 minutes.

- Hauser's 10 threes in 22:49 minutes of action is the fewest minutes played in a 10-three game in NBA history... He registered his career-high 27 points with 10:02 left in the third quarter while connecting on 9-of-11 from three.
- He tied the Celtics all-time record for most threes in a half:
 - 7 – Sam Hauser (3/17/24, 1H at WAS)
 - 7 – Jaylen Brown (10/23/23, 1H at WAS)
 - 7 – Derrick White (2/10/23, 1H vs CHA)
 - 7 – Kemba Walker (11/11/19, 2H vs DAL)

RECORD BREAKING NUMBERS

In the Celtics 127-112 win over Phoenix, Al Horford scored a season-high 24 points (8-14 FG) on a career-best 6-of-10 made three-pointers... Payton Pritchard is averaging a career single season high 2.7 assists per game this season and reached 500 career assists with a time at the 8:28 mark in the second quarter.

- For the fifth time in their careers, both Brown and Tatum scored at least 20 points in the first half, which last occurred on March 3 vs. Sacramento... The Celtics owned a 65-60 lead at halftime and now own a 44-9 record this season when leading at the break.
- The Celtics tied their season-high for points in a first quarter with 44 in the opening frame in their 123-107 win at Utah on March 12 and improved to 9-2 in the second night of a back-to-back... The 44 first-quarter points is tied for the third highest first quarter on the road in franchise history: 48 PTS – 2/12/82 at SDC; 45 PTS – 11/23/18 at ATL; 44 PTS – 3/12/24 at UTA; 44 PTS – 2/16/84 at GSW.
- The Celtics logged 70+ points in the first half tonight for a franchise-record 15th time this season, the most since registering 13 games in 1959-60... The C's 15 games is the most in the NBA this season, ahead of Sacramento in second with 13 games.

CELTICS WITH 1,000 CAREER MADE THREE-POINTERS

Jaylen Brown surpassed 1,000 career made three-pointers at the 9:36 mark of the 1st quarter in the Celtics' 117-107 win at Phoenix on March 9 and finished with 27 points (10-21 FG, 3-7 3FG), three rebounds, three assists, and two steals in the victory.

- Brown became the third Celtic in history to reach that mark, joining Paul Pierce and Jayson Tatum

AMONG NBA GREATS

In the Celtics 140-88 win over Golden State on March 3, Al Horford reached 14,000 career points with a turnaround bank hook at 7:33 in the third quarter.

- Horford became the sixth player in NBA history to record at least 14,000 points, 8,400 rebounds, 3,400 assists, and 1,200 blocks in a career, joining Kareem Abdul-Jabbar, Tim Duncan, Kevin Garnett, Pau Gasol, and Dirk Nowitzki.
- On 2/27, Jrue Holiday grabbed his 4,000th career rebound at the 8:44 mark in the first quarter vs. Philadelphia and became only the seventh active NBA guard with at least 4,000 career rebounds including James Harden, Russell Westbrook, Stephen Curry, DeMar DeRozan, Chris Paul, and Kyle Lowry.
- Jrue Holiday posted his eighth double-double of the season on 3/14 and 140th point-assist double-double in his career, which ranks ninth in the NBA among active players on March 14... Holiday finished with nine points, 10 assists, two steals, and two blocks to reach 500 career blocks and reached 1,400 career steals.

JAYSON TATUM NAMED FEBRUARY PLAYER OF THE MONTH

Tatum was named the Kia NBA Eastern Conference Player of the Month for February. Tatum earns his second NBA Player of the Month award this season (October/November) and he joins Larry Bird as the only two Celtics to earn multiple Player of the Month awards in a single season. Tatum's four career monthly honors is tied with Paul Pierce for the second-most awards in Celtics history, trailing only Bird with seven.

- In the month of February, Tatum was the only NBA player to average at least 27.0 points, 8.0 rebounds, and 6.0 assists while committing fewer than 2.5 turnovers per game. Tatum shot 48.0 percent from the field, 35.1 percent from three-point range, and 88.7 percent from the line. In the East, Tatum owned the second-best plus/minus (+13.5) and ranked third in scoring (27.2 ppg) for the month.
- Led the Celtics to a 9-1 record in February for the highest team-winning percentage in the NBA. During that stretch, Tatum registered 5+ assists and 5+ rebounds in nine straight games from Feb. 4 - 27, a feat that only six other NBA players have accomplished this season. The only Celtics who have recorded a longer such streak are Larry Bird (9x), John Havlicek (5x), and Bill Russell (1x).

JAYLEN BROWN COLLECTS NBA PLAYER OF THE WEEK HONORS

Brown has been named the NBA Eastern Conference Player of the Week for games played from Feb. 26 – Mar. 3. Brown earns his fourth career weekly honor and his first nod since collecting Player of the Week on March 27, 2023.

- Brown helped lead the Celtics to a 3-0 week with wins over Philadelphia (117-99), Dallas (138-110), and Golden State (140-88), while averaging 28.3 points, 5.3 rebounds, 3.0 assists, and 1.0 steals in 29.3 minutes per game. Brown was the only player in the NBA to average at least 28 points while shooting better than 60.0 percent from the field and 45.0 percent from three-point range (min. 3.0 3FGA) on the week.



FIRST TEAM IN NBA HISTORY WITH THREE 50+ POINT WINS

Boston posted their third-largest winning margin in franchise history with a 52-point win against the Warriors (140-88) on March 3... The Celtics also recorded their largest margin of victory against the Warriors in franchise history, beating out the previous record of 51 points on March 7, 1962 (153-102).

- The Celtics became the first team in NBA history to record three 50-point wins in a single season... The Celtics have won 13 of their last 15 games, including 11 straight for the longest overall winning streak in the NBA this season, and own the best home record at 29-3.
- On 3/3, Brown (25) and Tatum (22) combined for 47 points in the first half to extend their lead 82-38 at the break... The 44-point scoring margin is Boston's largest halftime lead in franchise history, beating out the previous high of 39 points that was achieved in 2007 against Denver and in 1987 against Philadelphia.
- Only three other teams in NBA history have recorded a 44-point differential at halftime, including the Dallas Mavericks (2020, 2014), Golden State Warriors (1991), and Seattle SuperSonics (1967), per Basketball Reference.

26 YEARS YOUNG

On March 1, Jayson Tatum scored 32 points while shooting 52.6 percent from the floor (10-19 FG) including 5-for-9 from three-point territory and added eight rebounds and three assists... Tatum passed Devin Booker for the sixth-most points scored by an NBA player before his 26th birthday with 11,381 career points and nearly reached Kobe Bryant next on the list at 12,215 points... Tatum turned 26 on March 3 and led the Celtics to a 140-88 win over the Warriors.

- He owns the most three-pointers made (1,239 3FG) by a player before his 26th birthday and has the fifth-most regular season wins (327).

EFFICIENT OFFENSE TOPS CHARTS

The Boston Celtics defeated the Nets for the second time in as many days with a 136-86 win at TD Garden on Feb. 14... The Celtics posted their largest margin of victory against the Nets in franchise history (+50) and earned their fifth 50-point win in Celtics history, four of which have come in the last six years.

- The Celtics owned a 101-55 lead after three quarters of action – the 46-point differential is for the second-largest lead entering the 4th quarter in franchise history following the record of 48 points vs. Baltimore on 11/27/70.
- Boston became the third team in NBA history to post two 50-point wins in a single season joining Milwaukee in 1978-79 and Sacramento in 1992-93.

GONE STREAKING

On Feb. 22 at the Chicago Bulls, Jayson Tatum tallied 25 points (8-17 FG, 5-10 3FG), seven rebounds, five assists and three steals in 35 minutes... Tatum has scored 20+ points in 13-straight games (1/22-2/22), marking the sixth time in his career that he has recorded such a streak... Tatum, Larry Bird (8x) and John Havlicek (6x) are the only players in Celtics history with six or more 20-point streaks spanning at least 13 games.

- The performance also marked the 13th consecutive game that Tatum had registered at least 20 points and seven rebounds dating back to Jan. 22, which stands as the third longest streak in Celtic history, trailing only Larry Bird with 15 games and Kevin McHale at 14.

2024 ALL-STAR WEEKEND

Jayson Tatum was selected to his fifth All-Star game while Jaylen Brown made his third All-Star appearance and was the first NBA All-Star to compete in the Dunk Contest in six seasons, where he advanced to the final round.

- Brown and Tatum combined for 59 points and 15 rebounds in the East's 211-186 win at the 2024 All-Star Game in Indianapolis... The Celtics duo will be a part of NBA history as the East scored the most total points in the All-Star game's 73-year history, beating out the previous mark of 196 points by the West in 2016... Brown finished with 36 points (15-23 FG, 6-12 3FG), eight rebounds, and three assists - Tatum registered 23 points (8-13 FG, 4-9 3FG) and seven rebounds.

TATUM BECOMES 5TH PLAYER IN NBA HISTORY TO REACH...

Tatum scored 41 points (14-26 FG, 5-11 3FG, 8-8 FT) and recorded 14 rebounds, five assists, two steals, one block and gave up only two turnovers in the Celtics 118-110 win against Brooklyn on Feb. 13.

- 5th player in NBA history to have a game with at least 40 points, 14 rebounds, 5 three-point field goals, five assists, and two steals, joining DeMarcus Cousins, Paul George, James Harden, and Russell Westbrook... Tatum is also the only player ever to accomplish that feat while committing fewer than 3 turnovers.
- He's now the second player in franchise history with 21 games of 35+ points and 10+ rebounds (Larry Bird, 51)... Tatum matched a career-high 31 points in the first half and owns all three instances of a Celtic scoring 30+ first-half points since the NBA began tracking play-by-play data in 1996-97 (2/13/24 at BKN – 31 PTS; 11/20/23 at CHO – 31 PTS; 1/23/22 at WAS – 31 PTS).

CELTICS TOP-5 MOST 40-POINT CAREER GAMES

Tatum is the second Celtic to ever reach 41 points, 14 rebounds, five assist, and two steals in a game, joining Larry Bird, on Feb. 13... The performance marked Tatum's 25th career 40-point game in the regular season while his 29 overall games (regular season + postseason), rank second in Celtics history.

Jayson Tatum approached a triple-double performance in only 30:48 minutes in the Celtics 131-91 win over Memphis on Feb. 4... He registered 34 points, eight rebounds, and seven assists while shooting 54.5 percent from the field (12-22 FG, 6-12 3FG).

- Tatum has knocked down at least six three-pointers in a team-high five games this season and has registered 33 career games with 6+ made threes which is the most such games by any player in Celtics history, followed by Antoine Walker with 18 and Paul Pierce and Jaylen Brown tied with 12.
- Tatum's 33 career games are also the second most such games by a forward/center in NBA history (list below):

CELTICS POST FOURTH-HIGHEST SCORING FIRST HALF IN FRANCHISE HISTORY

The Celtics won back-to-back games on the parquet with a 129-124 win over the Indiana Pacers on 1/30, and claimed the season series 3-2... This marks the first time the Celtics and Pacers competed against each other five times in the regular season since the 1988-89 season.

- The Celtics logged their fourth-highest scoring first half in franchise history with 81 points tonight vs. Indiana while connecting on 30-of-46 field goals (65.2 FG%), 12-of-20 three-pointers (60.0 3FG%), and 9-of-10 free throws (90.0)... The Celtics all-time record for most points scored in a single half is 91 points, which was accomplished twice, and both came in the second half of a game on Feb. 10, 1960, and Nov. 11, 1959.
- Since 1946-1947, only three other teams in NBA history have recorded at least 80 points in the first half while shooting greater than 65.0 percent from the field and 60.0 percent from deep, joining the Indiana Pacers (5/1/2021), New Orleans Pelicans (11/14/2014), and Los Angeles Lakers (1/2/1987).

JOE MAZZULLA AMONG COACHING GREATS

Joe Mazzulla is the fastest head coach in franchise history to reach 100 career regular season wins after accomplishing that feat on Feb. 14 in his 137th career game at the helm... Mazzulla tied John Kundla (Minnesota Lakers, 1950) as the fifth-fastest coach in NBA history to reach that milestone, in 137 games, joining an elite group of coaches including Steve Kerr (GSW) 117 games, Tom Thibodeau (CHI) 130 games, Avery Johnson (DAL) 131 games, and Red Auerbach (WAS. CAPS) 135 games.

- Mazzulla coached his 100th career game on 11/28/23 and lead the Celtics to a 124-97 win over the Chicago Bulls... Mazzulla boasts the best winning percent among head coaches with a least 100 career games on the bench:

CELTICS ALL STARS SHINE IN 33-POINT WIN OVER HEAT

Seven players scored in double-digits in the Celtics 143-110 win over the Miami Heat on Jan. 25... The C's 143 points were the most Boston has ever scored against Miami, and the 33-point margin represented Boston's largest margin of victory over the Heat in franchise history, including the playoffs... The Celtics 63.7 field goal percentage (51-80 FG) is the highest FG% in a game since 1972-73, when Boston shot 67.9 percent (55-81 FG) on 11/21/84 vs Golden State (W, 135-91).

- The C's shot 63.7 percent from the field, 55.0 percent from 3-point range, and 95.0 percent from the free-throw line, becoming the third team in NBA history to hit each of those marks in a game... Combined, those numbers equated to a true-shooting percentage of 80.5 percent, marking just the second time in league history that a team has reached the 80-percent mark (Utah holds the TS% record 80.8 percent 4/28/21).
- Every member of the starting lineup made at least three shots both from 3-point range and from 2-point range, marking the first time in NBA history that a team has had five players accomplish such a feat in the same game.
- Jayson Tatum scored 26 points Brown finished with 18 points to go along with four rebounds, five assists, and three steals while Jrue Holiday scored 17 points on 7-of-8 shooting and also tallied five rebounds and five assists... Derrick White logged 15 points, six rebounds, six assists, and two blocks...Kristaps Porzingis scored 19 points on 6-of-9 shooting, including 3-of-4 from long range.

TATUM FILLS UP THE STAT SHEET IN DALLAS

The Celtics improved their league-leading 34-10 overall record with a 119-110 win over the Dallas Mavericks on Jan. 22... Jayson Tatum became the first player in NBA history to register at least 39 points, 11 rebounds, five assists, three steals, two blocks, and zero turnovers in a game... Jaylen Brown scored 34 points (13-22 FG, 6-9 FT) along with four assists, three rebounds, a pair of blocked shots in the victory.

- Tatum has registered at least 39 points and 11 rebounds in seven career games with ranks second in Celtics history behind only Larry Bird with 24 such games, while Jaylen Brown is tied with Paul Pierce for the fourth-most games with 4 each.
- Tatum posted the 25th game in NBA history with at least 39 points, 11 rebounds, five assists, and two blocks in a game.
- Jaylen Brown and Jayson Tatum are the first teammates in NBA history to each log 30+ points, 2+ blocks, and 0 turnovers in the same game

HISTORIC NIGHT IN HOUSTON

Jaylen Brown recorded his third career triple-double with 13 points, 11 rebounds, and a season-high 10 assists in the Celtics' 116-107 win on Jan. 21 in Houston... Brown became the seventh Celtic to record a triple-double with 3+ steals in a game, joining: Larry Bird (18x), Rajon Rondo (8x), Paul Pierce (3x), Antoine Walker (2x), Dave Cowens, and Kevin Gamble... His three career triple doubles are tied with Evan Turner for the ninth-most triples by a Celtic in franchise history.

- Kristaps Porzingis posted 32 points and went 11-of-20 from the field and 6-of-11 from 3-point range and added six rebounds and five blocks... His performance marks the 10th time in NBA history a player logged five blocks and six threes in a game.
- Porzingis is the third player in NBA history to record at least 30 points, six three-pointers, and five blocks in a game, which he also accomplished in 2020, making up 2 of the 5 total such games in NBA history: Kristaps Porzingis (2020; 2024), Brook Lopez (2017), and former Celtic Raef LaFrentz (2002 x2)

JAYS COMBINE FOR 80 POINTS TO TOP WOLVES

The Jays combined for 80 points behind Jayson Tatum's 45 points and Jaylen Browns 35 points – their highest combined scoring total ever – to lift the Celtics to a 127-120 overtime win over Minnesota's No. 1 ranked defense in the league, pushing Boston to its first 18-0 start at home in franchise history... The closest they'd come to 80 combined previously was when they combined to score 79 points against the Timberwolves on April 9, 2021.

- It marked the fourth time in their careers that Brown and Tatum scored at least 35 points apiece in the same game... It's only happened five other times in Celtics history, and they're the only pair to do it more than once.

BOSTON BOASTS HOME COURT ADVANTAGE

The Celtics' franchise record 20 consecutive wins at the TD Garden is tied with the 1952-53 Syracuse Nationals and 1985-86 Houston Rockets for the 11th best home start in NBA history.

- On January 10, the Celtics set a new franchise record for the most consecutive home wins to start a season with a perfect 18-0 after defeating the Minnesota Timberwolves 127-120 in overtime at TD Garden on January 10... Boston also won 18 straight during the 1957-58 season if you include neutral site home games, as the Celtics played one on Jan. 5, 1958, in Providence, RI.
- The Celtics posted a 27-game win streak at TD Garden dating back to March 8, 2023, which is the third-longest regular season home win streak in franchise history – 38 wins (12/10/85 to 11/28/86); 33 wins (12/17/86 to 11/18/87):

MAZZULLA NAMED EASTERN CONFERENCE COACH OF THE MONTH

Head Coach Joe Mazzulla was named the NBA Eastern Conference Coach of the Month for games played in December... Mazzulla earns his second career monthly honor and is tied for the third most Coach of the Month awards in franchise history, behind Doc Rivers (6) and Brad Stevens (3).

- The Celtics posted the best overall record in the league with a 12-2 mark while their .857 winning percentage ranks seventh in franchise history for the month of December and the highest since 2007-08 (.929)... The C's also owned the best winning percentage against .500 or better opponents with an 8-1 record (.889).
- The Celtics' 126.5 points per game ranked second in the NBA after the Bucks (131.5), and ranked fourth in NBA history for the highest December scoring average, behind the Atlanta Hawks in 2020-21 and Baltimore Bullets in 1965-66... Boston averaged the most three-pointers in the NBA with 16.6 makes per game behind the sixth-best three-point shooting percentage (39.2) and ranked third in effective field goal percentage (58.6).

HOT HANDS GIVE WAY TO A HOT START

In a player's first 27 games of a season (in the 3-point era), only three players have recorded at least 125 assists, 100 rebounds, 30 blocks, and 30 steals and shot at least 40.0 percent from three and an 80.0 percent free throw percentage: Derrick White, Larry Bird (2x) and Michael Jordan.

- Only two Celtics have averaged at least 16.0 points, 5.0 assists, 1.0 blocks, and 1.0 steals - Larry Bird (1984-85, 1990-91) and Derrick White (2023-24),
- White scored 10 points in overtime against Detroit, which was tied for the third-most points scored in an overtime period in the NBA this season and he becomes the seventh Celtic to score in double-digits in a single overtime: Paul Pierce, Kyrie Irving, Jaylen Brown, Kevin Garnett, Jared Sullinger, Jayson Tatum
- Recorded at least two blocks in five straight games (12/19-12/28) and is tied with Dwyane Wade and Mookie Blaylock for the longest such streak by an NBA guard since 1971-72.
- White owns the most blocks by a guard over a 5-game span in NBA history with 14 blocks (12/17-12/25/23) and joins Hall of Famer Dwyane Wade as the only two guards to register multiple 5-game spans with 13+ blocks.

CELTICS ON CHRISTMAS DAY

The Boston Celtics matched up against the Lakers on Christmas Day for the first time since 2008 and registered a 126-115 win in LA, while all five starters scored at least 18 points.

- The Celtics played on Christmas for the eighth consecutive year and own a 17-20 overall record on Christmas Day with their first appearance coming in 1948 – Home 2-2; Road 14-17; Neutral 1-1 (1956 and 1964).
- Jayson Tatum scored 41 points against Milwaukee on Christmas Day last year, the second-highest total for a Celtics player on Christmas... Kristaps Porzingis ranks fourth in NBA history for the most blocks per game on Christmas Day with 3.33 blocks in his three Christmas appearances (min 2 GP).
- Jrue Holiday recorded six steals with New Orleans at Denver in 2019, which is tied for the second-most steals on Christmas in NBA history, trailing only seven steals by Kyrie Irving in 2016 (Cleveland vs. Golden State).

DERRICK DOMINATING BOTH ENDS OF THE COURT

Derrick White logged 18 points, three rebounds, and three assists vs the Clippers on 12/23... He recorded three blocked shots for the fourth straight game, making him just the second guard in NBA history to do so along with Chicago's Ron Harper in 1999.

- White registered 28 points on 10-of-13 made field goals and 6-of-9 three-pointers along with seven assists, three blocks and a steal on 12/20 vs. SAC following his 30 points (11-24 FG, 7-18 3FG), seven rebounds, three blocks performance on 12/19 vs. GSW.
- Became the sixth Celtic since 1967-68 to hit at least six three-pointers in consecutive games joining: Sam Hauser, Eddie House, Jayson Tatum, Antoine Walker, and Kemba Walker.
- There have only been two Celtics all time to record three blocks and at least seven 3-pointers in a game:
 - Derrick White (8 3FG, 3 BLK) on 2/20/23 vs. Charlotte ; Derrick White (7 3FG, 3 BLK) 12/19/23 at Golden State

STRONG SECOND UNIT

Sam Hauser scored a season-high 22 points, the fifth 20-point game of his career, and posted his 9th career game with at least five three-pointers off the bench (6-10 3FG), on March 11 at Portland, which is tied with Payton Pritchard for the most such games in Celtic history.

CELTICS BREAKING FRANCHISE RECORDS

The C's defeated the Clippers, who had been riding a hot streak with nine wins in their last 10 games, on Dec. 23, 145-108 ... The Celtics knocked down at least 25 three-pointers for the sixth time in franchise history and tied the most made threes by any team this season (SAC/BKN)... The Celtics 47 makes from long distance against the Clippers (25-53 3FG) and Kings (22-42 3FG) were the most in a two-game span in franchise history.

- In the win, Boston tied an NBA record by having six different players make at least three 3-pointers in a game, led by Tatum with five makes, Jrue Holiday with four, and Oshae Brissett, Payton Pritchard, Jaylen Brown, and Derrick White with three makes apiece.
- Boston scored 289 points over the last two contests, marking its highest total in a two-game span since November of 1966 when it beat the Baltimore Bullets in back-to-back nights by scores of 143-119 and 147-125.



- It also marked the first time in franchise history that the C's scored at least 144 points in consecutive games, a feat that had only been accomplished seven times prior in NBA history.

BROWN AND TATUM EARN 300TH WIN

The long tenured Celtics, Jaylen Brown and Jayson Tatum won their 300th win together (regular + postseason)... The most wins by a Celtics duo was by Robert Parish and Kevin McHale who went 754-352 together.

- With their 300th win, Brown and Tatum will join the group below as active teammates (both players active), with 300 career wins together in the reg. season and postseason combined.

BOSTON'S TEAM EFFORT DEFEATS BUCKS

The Boston Celtics maintained their place atop the East standings after defeating the Milwaukee Bucks, 119-116, at TD Garden and remain undefeated on home court (6-0)... The Celtics (9-0) are now one of two teams to boast a perfect record on home court this season, alongside the Denver Nuggets (9-0).

- Seven players scored in double-figures as the Celtics bench outscored the Bucks second unit 31-22 with performances from Sam Hauser (10 pts), Al Horford (11 pts) and Payton Pritchard (10pts). There have been only two other times for Boston over the last 20 seasons where each bench player who saw action scored in double figures: March 3, 2018 – 4 players and Dec. 31, 2021 – 3 players.

HOLIDAY HITS 15,000 CAREER POINTS/6,000 CAREER ASSISTS

Jrue Holiday surpassed 15,000 career points on Nov. 13 vs Toronto when he finished with 14 points while going 5-for-9 from the floor and 3-for-5 from three-point range... Holiday scored his 15,000th career point on a three-pointer with 10.6 seconds left in the third quarter and became the 18th active player to reach the milestone.

- Holiday is the sixth active player with 6,000 career assists, trailing Chris Paul, LeBron James, Russell Westbrook, James Harden, Kyle Lowry, and Mike Conley.
- Since 1971-72, Holiday became the sixth NBA player to record at least 15,200 points, 6,000 assists, and 475 blocked shots alongside LeBron James, Kobe Bryant, James Harden, Clyde Drexler, and Scottie Pippen.

TATUM NAMED PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Tatum was named the NBA Eastern Conference Player of the Week, on November 6... Tatum collects his 10th career nod and ranks third in Celtics history for the most NBA Player of the Week honors behind Paul Pierce (17) and Larry Bird (15)... he led the NBA in scoring last week with 31.7 points per game and was one of only two NBA players to average at least 30.0 points and 9.0 rebounds as he led the Celtics to a perfect 3-0 record - against Washington (126-107), Indiana (155-104), and Brooklyn (124-114).

- Tatum scored at least 30 points in all three contests while shooting 58.9 percent from the field and 54.2 percent from three and played in only the first three quarters of each game against Washington and Indiana. In 31.7 minutes per game, he knocked down the most made three-pointers in the Eastern Conference with 4.3 threes per game.

YOUNGEST CELTIC TO REACH 10,000 CAREER POINTS

Jayson Tatum scored his 10,000 career point in the second quarter of Saturday's 124-114 win over the Brooklyn Nets... The 25-year-old Tatum passed Antoine Walker to claim status as youngest player in franchise history achieve the feat... Tatum is the 10th player in NBA history to reach 10,000 career points before his 26th birthday, joining LeBron James, Kobe Bryant, Kevin Durant, Carmelo Anthony, Tracy McGrady, Devin Booker, Bob McAdoo, Giannis Antetokounmpo and Dwight Howard.

- He's the 15th player in NBA history to reach 10,000 points before turning 26.
- Only player in NBA history to log 10,000 points and 1,000 made three-pointers before turning 26.
- The first player in NBA history to reach 10,000 points and 1,000 made three pointers at age 25 or younger.
- He is the youngest Celtic to reach 10k points and the third fastest in terms of games played...

THIRD-LARGEST MARGIN OF VICTORY IN CELTICS HISTORY

Boston defeated the Indiana Pacers, 155-104, at TD Garden on November 1 as eight Celtics scored in double figures for only the ninth time since 2005... The Celtics scored 150+ points for the 10th time in franchise history and marked the first time since November 25, 1992, when they defeated the Washington Bullets, 150-112... The C's 155 total points is the second-highest score in franchise history, behind only the record 173 points in 1959 against the Minneapolis Lakers.

- The C's 51-point win over the Pacers is tied for the third-largest margin of victory during the regular season in franchise history – 56 points at Chicago (133-77) on 12/8/18; 53 points vs. Sacramento (128-75) on 1/25/22; and 51 points (153-102) against the Philadelphia Warriors on 3/7/1962.
- The Celtics high-scoring offense set multiple franchise records, including the first time the C's scored 75+ points in the first half in back-to-back games, following their 77-51 lead over Washington on Oct. 30... This also marked the first time Boston registered a 35-point lead against an opponent in consecutive games (over the past 25 seasons since play-by-play data has been tracked).
- The Celtics jumped out to a 44-27 lead in the first quarter behind 16-of-21 made field goals and 8-of-11 made three-pointers, led by Derrick White's 11 points (4-5 FG, 3-4 3FG)... The last time the Celtics had consecutive 40+-point first quarters came on Feb. 5, 1982 (50 points) and Feb. 7, 1982 (40 points), including Boston's 42 points in the first against Washington on Monday night.

THE DYNAMIC DUO

The Celtics 119-110 win against Dallas marked the 29th time that Tatum (39 points) and Brown (34 points) scored 30+ in the same game... Brown and Tatum have each scored 30+ points in 29 games, which is the most such games by a Celtics duo, with Larry Bird and Kevin McHale in second with 11 such games.

- Jayson Tatum scored 38 points (14-23 FG, 8-13 3FG) along with 13 rebounds, six assists, and a steal and Jaylen Brown registered 31 points (13-20 FG), four rebounds, and a block in the Celtics 118-101 win over Indiana on Jan. 6.
- On Dec. 23, 2023 both Jaylen Brown and Jayson Tatum scored 30+ points in their 17th regular-season game together, which pushes them past Michael Jordan and Scottie Pippen into third place for most 30-point games by teammates in the NBA since 1985.

PORZINGIS RECORDS HIGHEST-SCORING CELTICS DEBUT

Kristaps Porzingis made a tiebreaking 3-pointer with 1:29 left in the game and then knocked down a pair of free throws to gain a four-point lead with 29 seconds on the clock to help Boston beat New York 108-104 on Wednesday night in the season opener.

- Porzingis set a franchise record for the highest-scoring Celtics debut with 30 points, surpassing Dominique Wilkins' mark of 25 points on Nov. 4, 1994, also against the Knicks... he finished with 30 points (8-15 FG, 5-9 3FG, 9-10 FT), eight rebounds, and four blocks while also holding the Knicks to 20.0 percent shooting (3-15 FG) when contesting a shot... he became the first player in NBA history to record five made three pointers and four blocks in a team debut.

Joe Mazzulla is entering his second season at the helm of the Boston Celtics after he was named the 19th head coach in franchise history on February 16, 2023.

Mazzulla enters his fifth season with the organization after serving as an assistant coach for three years. In his first season as head coach, Mazzulla led the Celtics to the Eastern Conference Finals and claimed the Atlantic Division title with a 57-25 record, which marked the team's most regular season wins since 2008-09. Mazzulla was named the NBA All-Star Head Coach when the C's clinched the best record in the Eastern Conference on Jan. 30 with a 36-15 overall mark for the highest win percentage in the NBA (.706). Mazzulla joined the Celtics after being the Head Coach for the Fairmont State men's basketball program for two seasons. He was the 12th head coach in the history of the program. He recorded a record of 43-17 in his two seasons at the helm of the Fighting Falcons. A former West Virginia University standout, Mazzulla spent five years coaching at the NCAA Division II level, including three at Fairmont State.

Mazzulla has also served as an assistant coach for the Maine Red Claws of the NBA Gatorade League. Prior to his position with the Red Claws, Mazzulla was an assistant coach for three seasons on Jerrod Calhoun's staff at Fairmont State. During that time, the Falcons compiled a record of 67-26 with three 20-win seasons and a pair of NCAA Tournament appearances. Mazzulla started his coaching career by spending two seasons as an assistant coach at Glenville State. In his time with the Pioneers, Mazzulla helped develop two All-WVIAC honorees and a pair of all-freshman team honorees.

Prior to beginning his coaching career, Mazzulla played four seasons at West Virginia University for head coaches John Beilein and Bob Huggins. His teams made four-straight NCAA Tournament appearances, including a berth in the Final Four in 2010.

Mazzulla also won a Big East Tournament Championship and NIT Tournament Championship at WVU and the standout also excelled in the classroom, getting named to Big East Academic All-Star Team three times (2007, 2009 and 2010).
